



Miroslav Nikolić is tenured principal scientist and leader of Plant Nutrition research group at the University of Belgrade's Institute for Multidisciplinary Research (Serbia). Currently, he is President of the International Society for Silicon in Agriculture (ISSAG). His primary research interests are plant-soil interactions, root acquisition and transport of nutrients, and the impact of minerals in food crops, with particular focus on silicon. Miroslav has published book "Silicon in Agriculture" with Springer in 2015, more than 70 international peer-refereed articles and 8 invited international book chapters, including his contribution in the fourth edition of prestigious "Marschner's Mineral Nutrition of Plants" in 2023. His papers have been cited more than 5,000 times and his h-index is 37 (Google Scholar). Miroslav is Section Editor of Plant and Soil (Springer-Nature) and serves on the Editorial Boards of 8 peer-refereed international journals.
